You can get to Luton Point by train, bus or car. There are disabled parking spaces available.



There are 3 main entrances to Luton Point:

St George's Circus. There is lift access and escalators here.



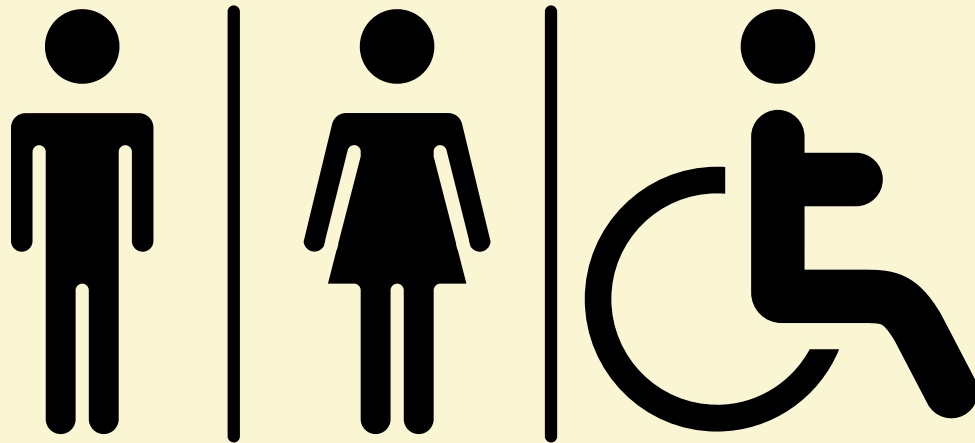
George's Street. There is step-free access from the street here.



Silver Street. There is lift access here. The escalators are currently out of use here.



There are bathrooms, including disabled toilets, available at Luton Point.



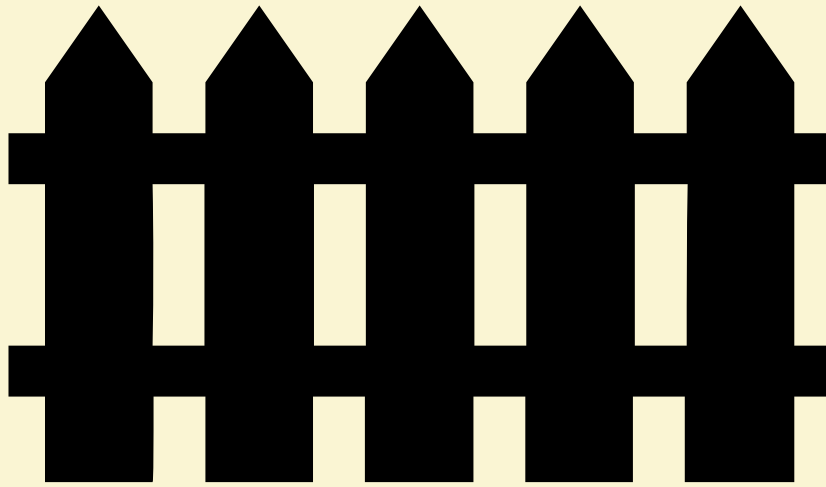
The main facilities, featuring men's, ladies', disabled and parent facilities, are situated off Bute Square next door to H&M. There are more toilets located at the entrance to the indoor market in Church Street.



Taroo and Human Flag will take place inside Luton Point at Central Square.



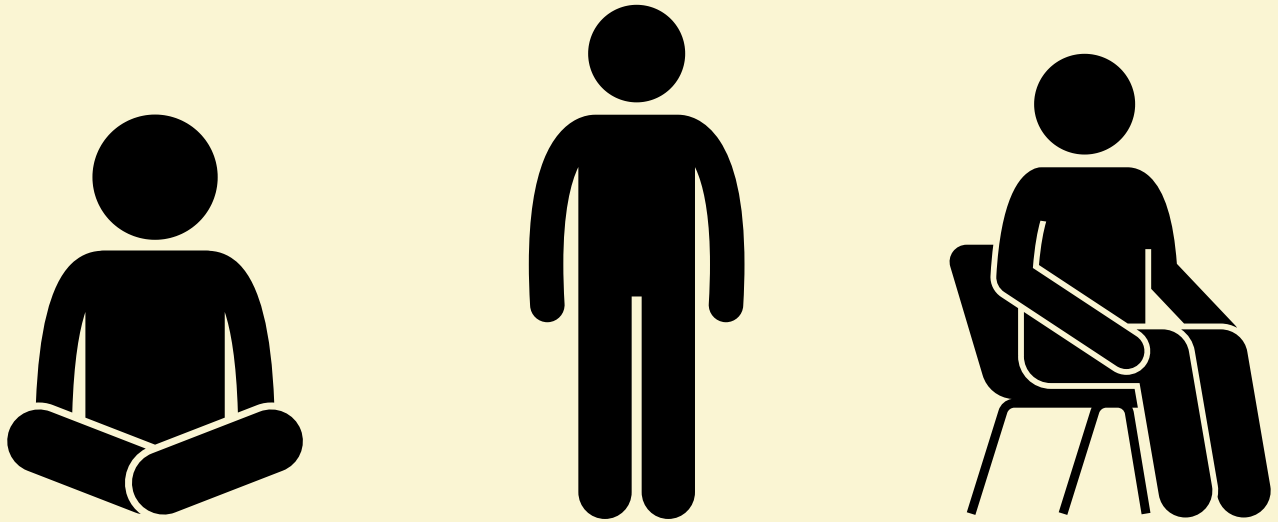
The show will take place in a fenced-off area of Central Square.

Human Flag is a contemporary circus performance. There will be acrobatics, movement and dance.

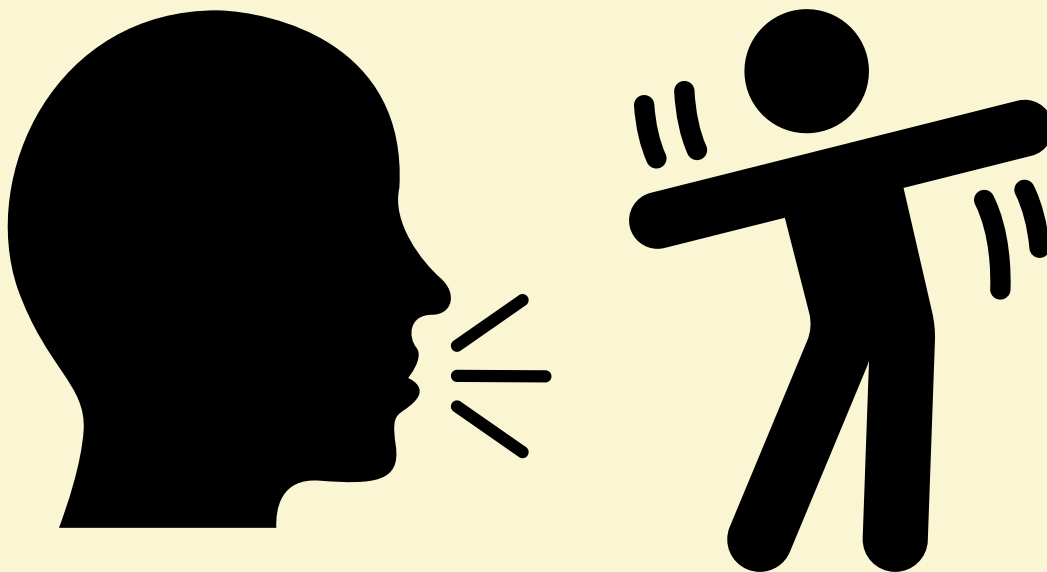
Human Flag is performed by Brahim Ech Chibi.



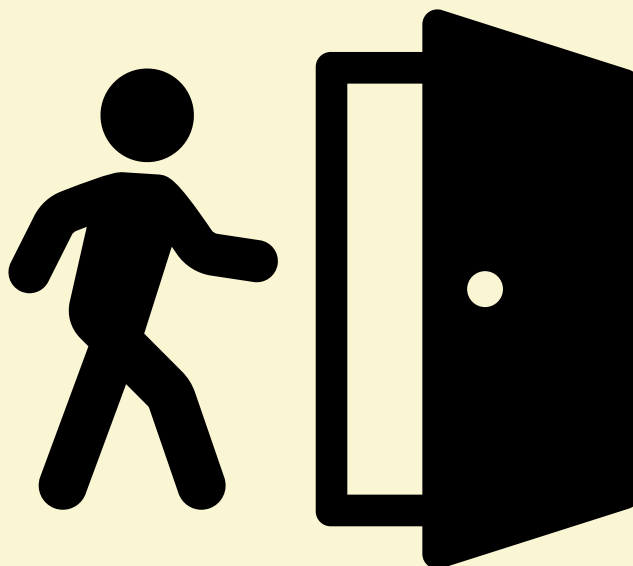
The show will last 7 minutes. There is no intermission.

Taroo is performed by Said Mouhssine.

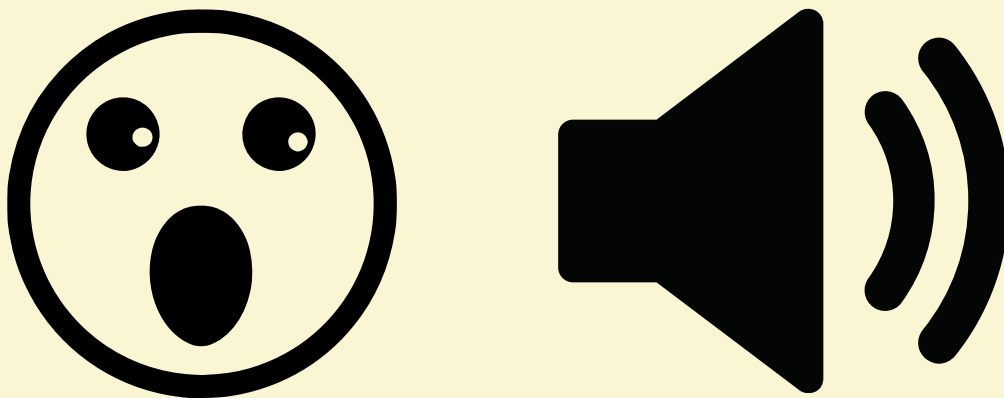


The show will last 40 minutes. There is no intermission.

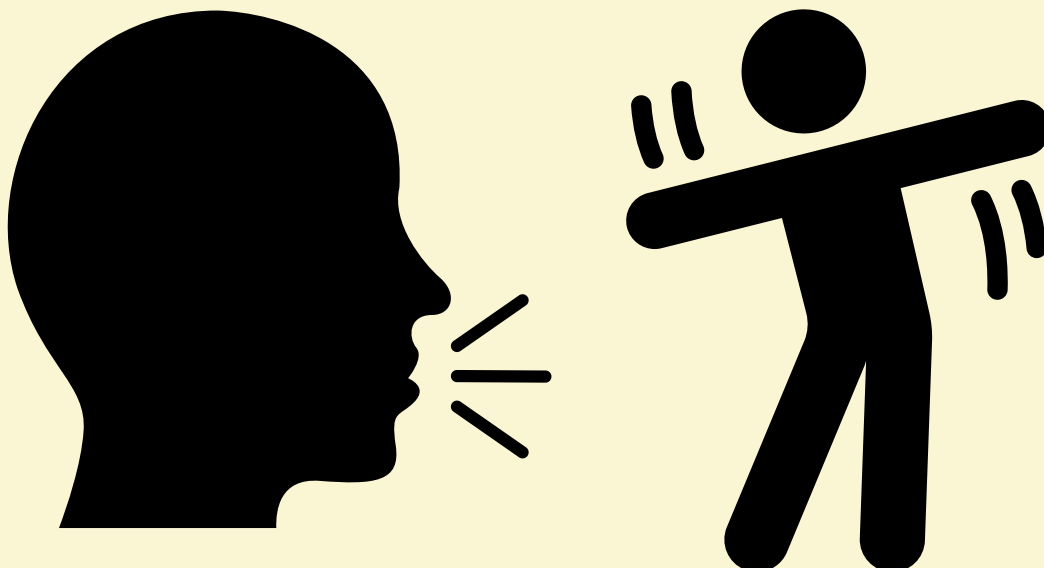


At the start of the show, there will be a sound that you may find surprising.

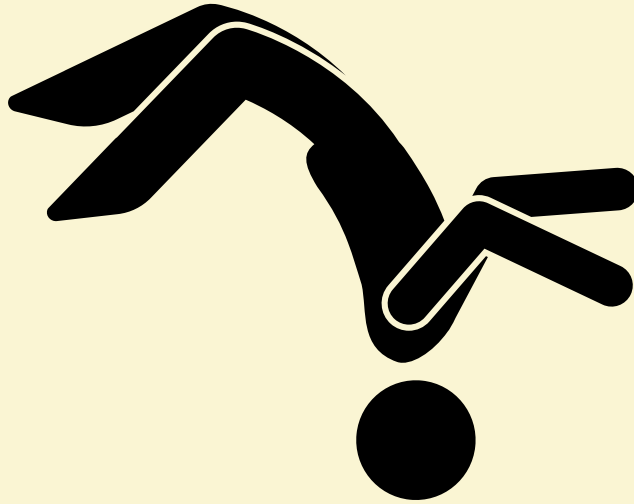
This sound will **not** be loud or sudden.



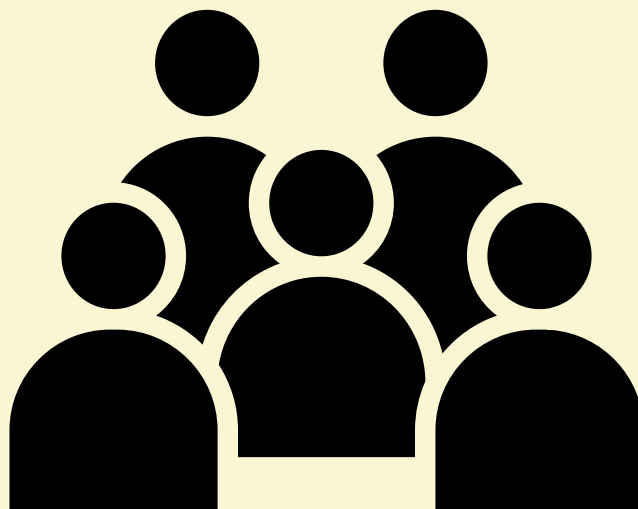
During the show, you can make sounds and move if you need to.



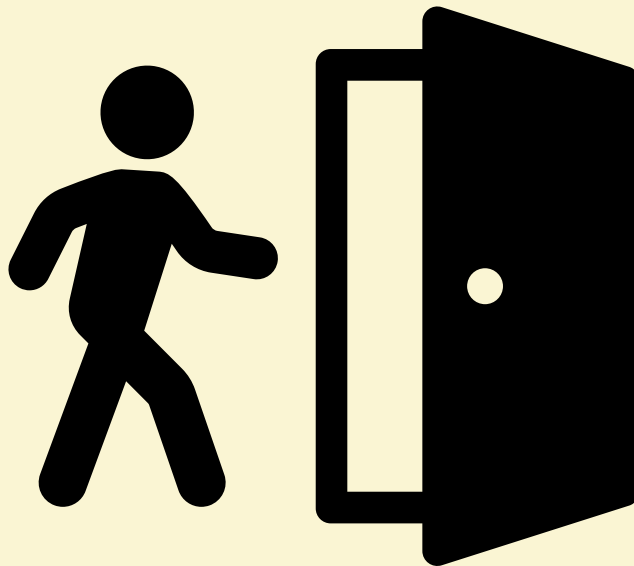
There will be acrobatics happening close to the audience.
