Luton Henge Festival is a **free outdoor festival in Luton**.

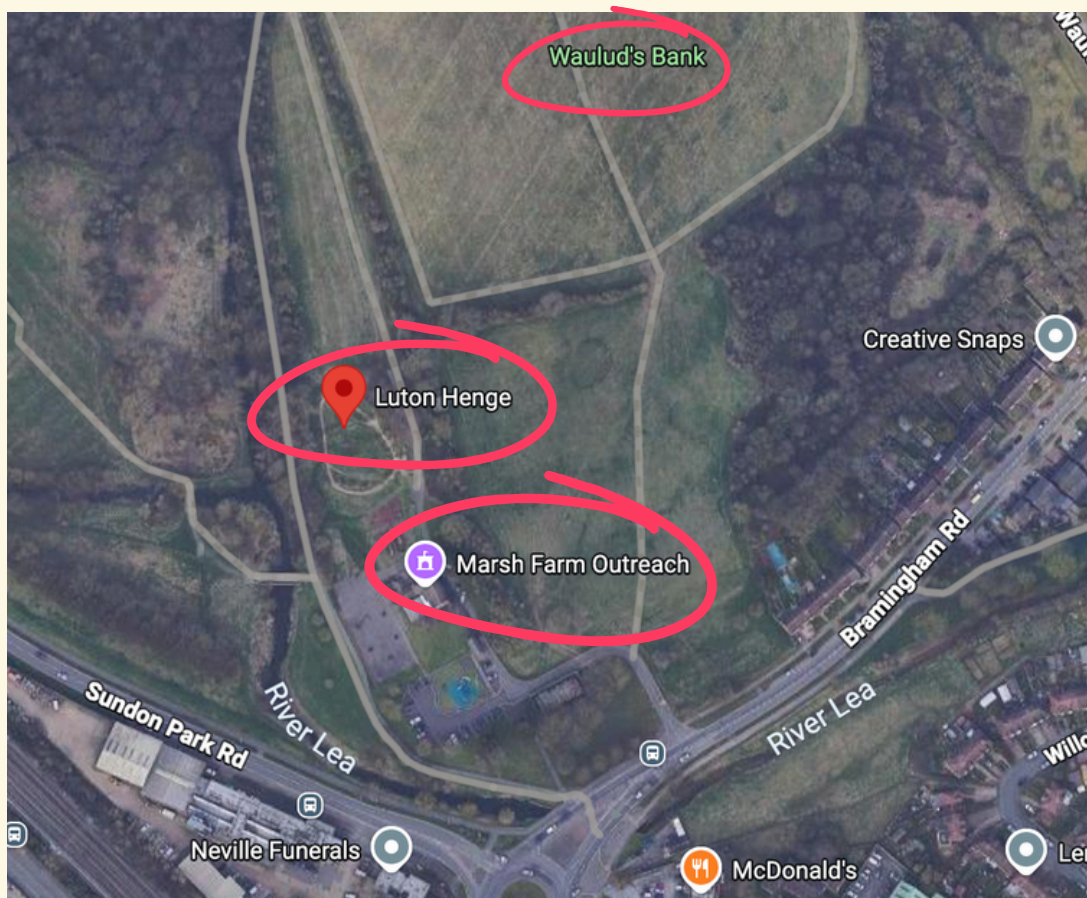


There will be **music, performances, workshops, art, food** and lots of people enjoying the festival together.

The festival takes place across **Marsh Farm Outreach, Luton Henge and Waulud's Bank.**

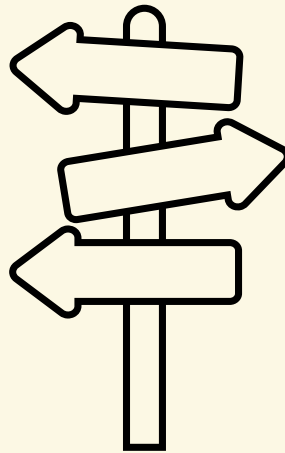
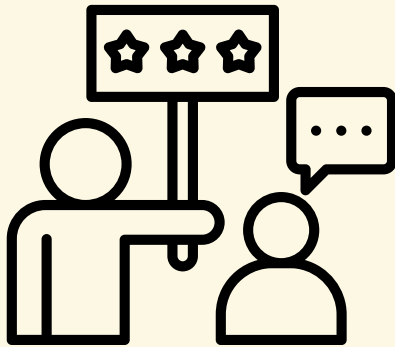


There are lots of ways to get to Luton Henge Festival. You might travel by **car, bus, train, walk, or cycle.**

Festival staff and volunteers will be there to welcome visitors and answer questions.



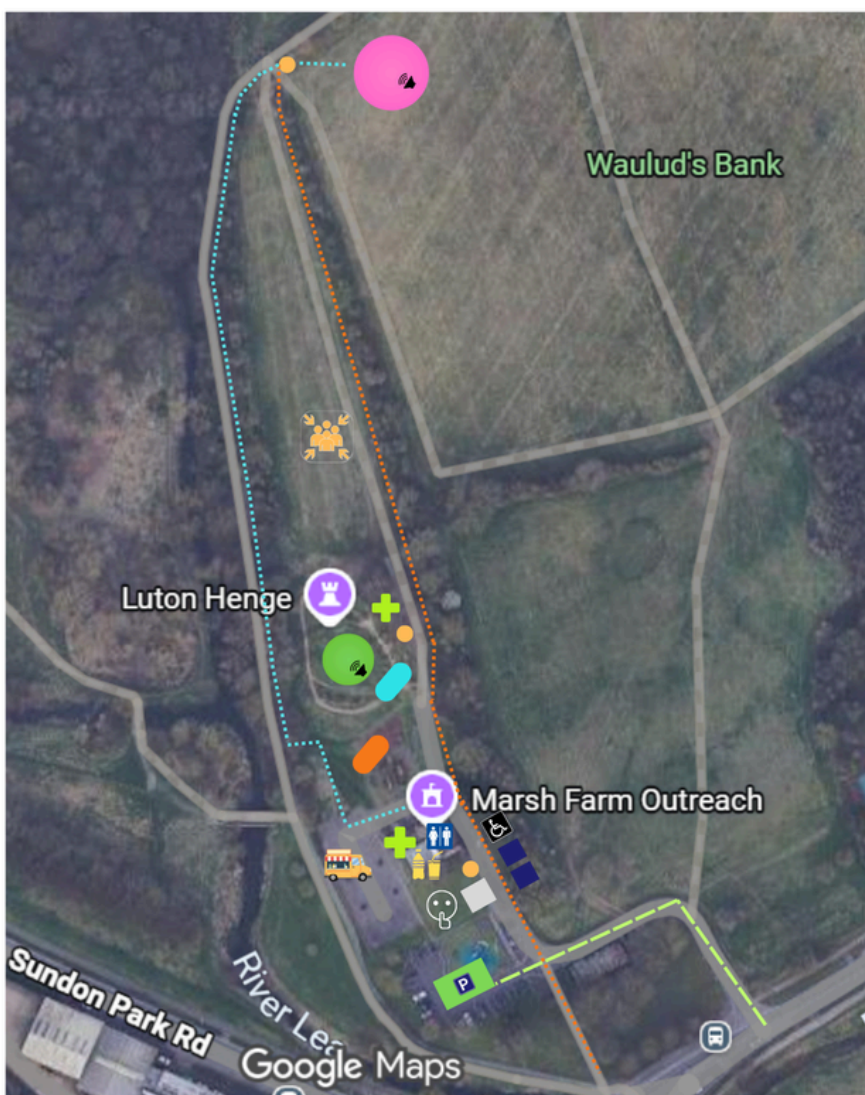
If you need **support or assistance** at any time, please speak to a member of staff who will be **wearing a Revoluton Arts branded high-vis vest**.

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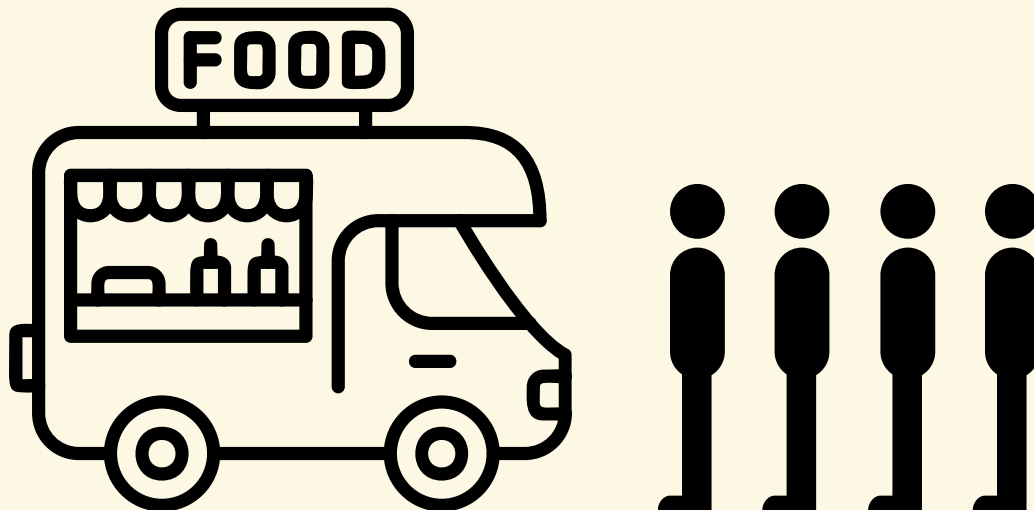


You do not need to visit every area. **You can choose where you would like to go.**

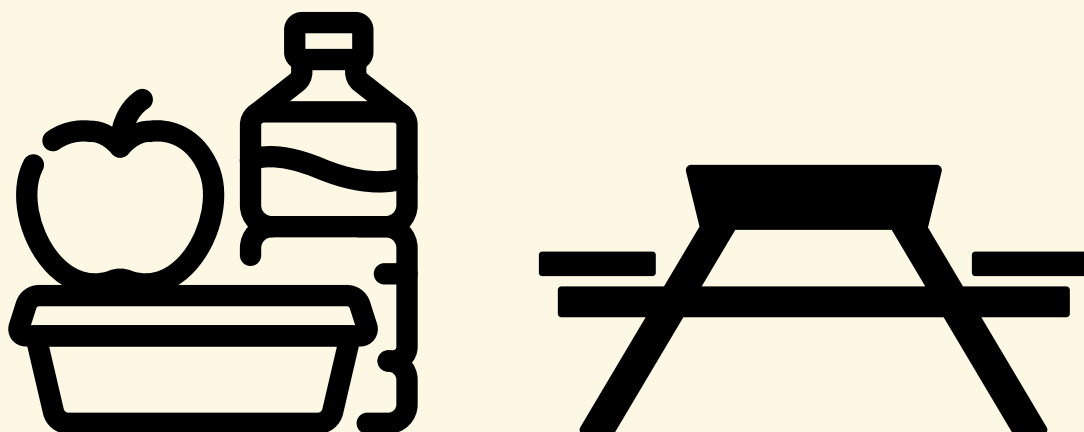
There are also places to sit and rest during your visit.

Some performances may **move around the festival**.

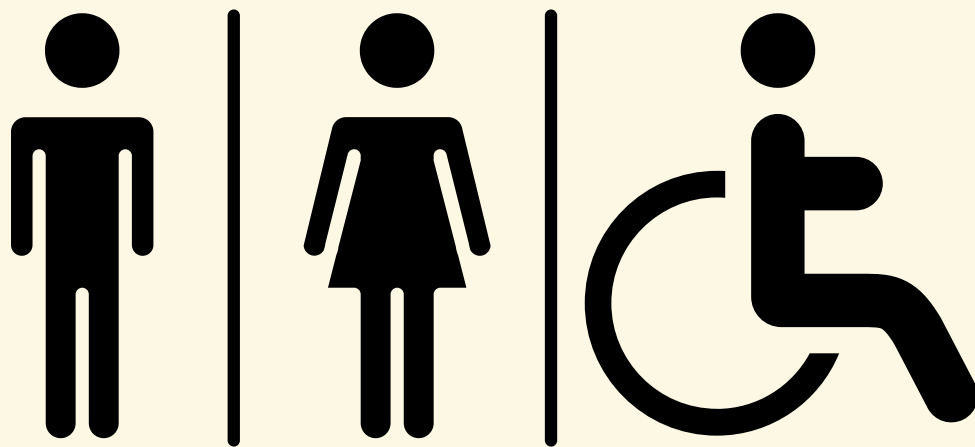


People may stand, sit, dance, clap or sing along.

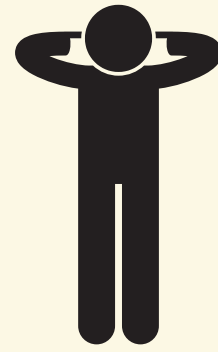


There will be toilets at the festival, **including accessible toilets.**

If you are not sure where they are, you can **check the map** or **ask a member of staff** in a Revolution Arts branded high-vis vest.

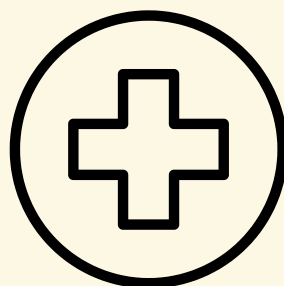
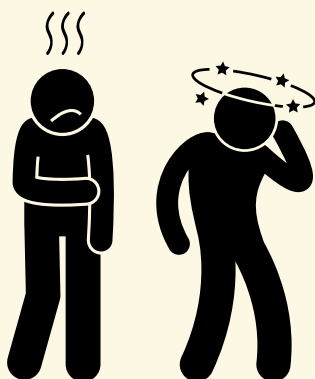

When you are ready, you can leave the festival.
