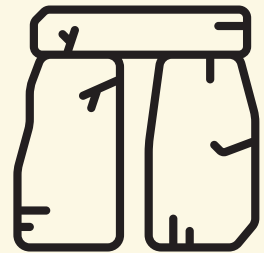
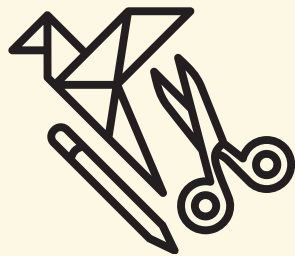

We hope you enjoy your visit!



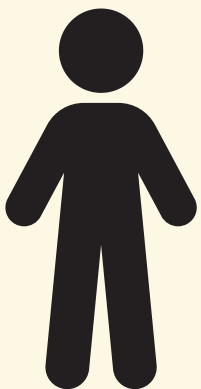
Live Music, DJs and Sound Installations



You can enjoy live music and sound installations throughout the festival.

Some performances will happen in a designated area, and others may happen around the festival.

People may stand, dance, clap or sing along.





You can stay for a few minutes or watch a whole performance.

You can stand near the performance area or watch from further away.

If the music or sound feels too loud, you can move away or visit another area of the festival.



You might see and hear: Lavz, UKCCA Steel Pan, Ryussi DJ Set, Exodus DJ Set, PLATFORM Artists, Marsh Farm Young Collective, Dhols Royce, Neolithic Cannibals, I Have No Name.



Theatre, Circus and Moving Performers



Some performers tell stories through words, theatre, puppetry, circus or movement.

Some performances happen in a designated area.

Others move around the festival and may interact with visitors.

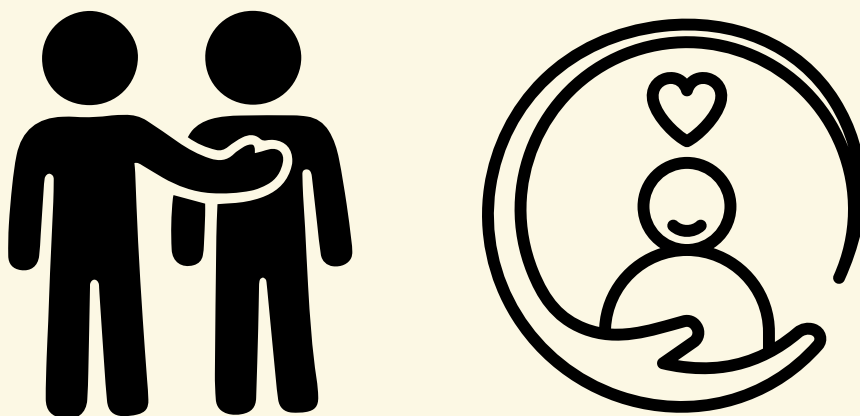
They may wave, smile or say hello.



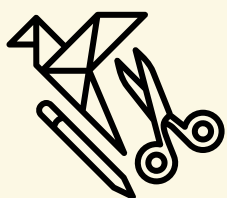


Sometimes they may invite people to join in.

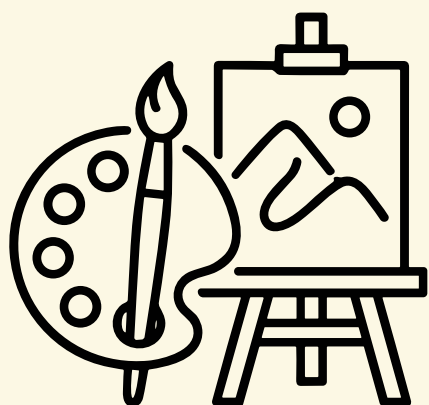


Workshops and Creative Activities

You might **make something, try a new skill or watch other people taking part.**

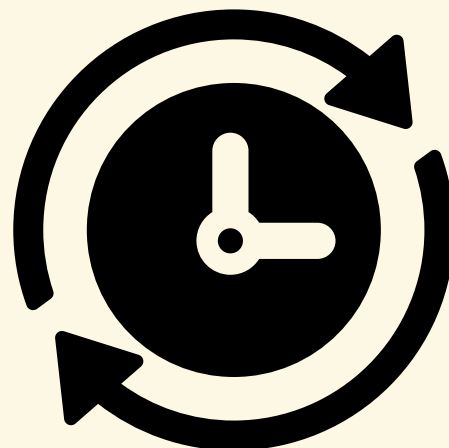
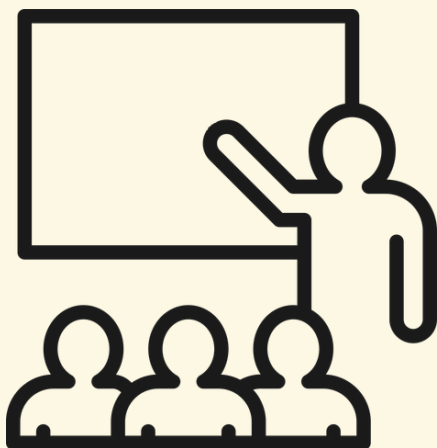




Some activities are **workshops with a facilitator**.

You might see or take part in: street art, ceramics, writing, craft activities or flint knapping.

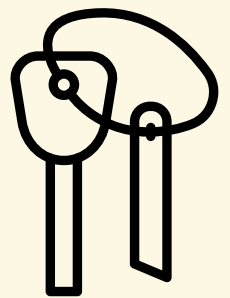


Explore the Henge
